What's Inside

- **Meet the Artists:** Samba to Salsa are three Philly artists from diverse backgrounds. They're inspired by Afro-Latin and Brazilian rhythms to connect with their roots and bring people together to dance and sing.
- **Activity 1:** Using household items, you'll get crafty and build a new instrument Samba to Salsa's Andres calls the Cinco Mano (or, five hands).
- **Activity 2:** Learn how to use your new Cinco Mano to play rhythms and sounds inspired by five Afro-Caribbean percussion instruments.
- **Educators Guide:** This handy one-sheet includes key vocabulary and guiding questions that reinforce concepts learned through the artists' performance and activities. It also has cross-curricular connections with STEM, geography and history activities.
